PROJECT EARTHEN COOLER

Earthen cooler, an invention of our young scientists, that secured the school 8th position at the national level competition, along with the funding of Rupees one lacs fifty thousand.

Inspired by the rural Indian practice of keeping edible things and water cool during summers using earthen vessels, when sprayed with water or covered with wet jute cloth. Our students, under the guidance of the teachers, proposed, designed and developed an innovative device to keep us cool during the hot summers, Earthen cooler.

The students had built this device sustainably, by reusing the materials that were already available in school. The working of the Earthen Cooler is quite ingenious and simple, on one end the device is pulling in water, using a motor, wetting the terracotta plates and when the blow of hot air touches the wet terracotta plates, it rapidly cools down and giving a light blow of the cooler air to the person sitting in the other end of the Earthen Cooler.

This project is deeply in line with our mission for a green and sustainable earth, as it reduces the by products generated from air conditioning, working on minimal energy and is built sustainably.

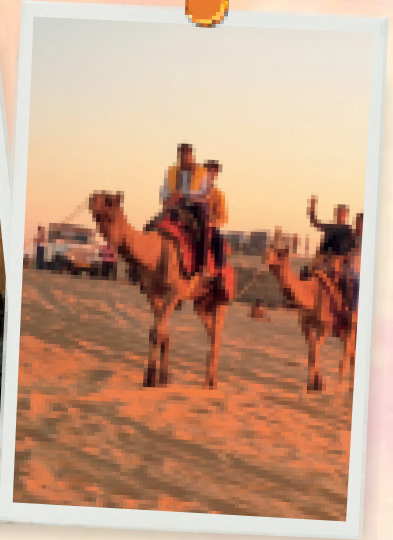
Visit to the Post Office

It was a fun day filled with lots of learning on the way.

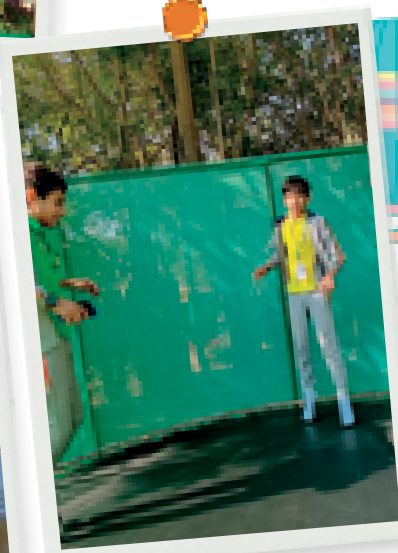


Jaisalmer - Jodhpur Tour

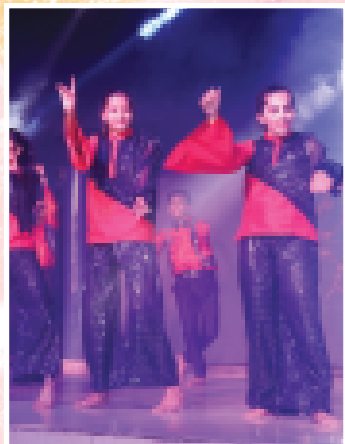
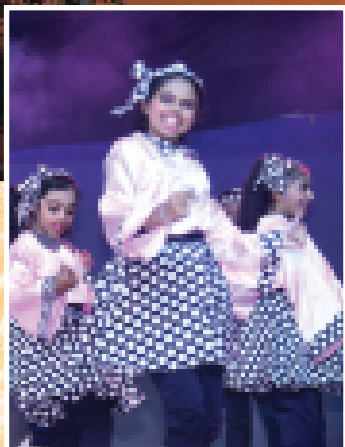


YOUNG SCIENTISTS
